NC Goal: 2 million North Carolinians ages 25– 44 will hold a highquality degree or credential by 2030.

### What is FAFSA?

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®)
- FAFSA unlocks access to financial aid at the federal, state, and college level








# Why do we need a NC FAFSA Tracker?

- Cost is the top barrier to attending college
- FAFSA completion is a strong predictor of Fall college enrollment
- FAFSA is one of the few metrics we can get in real time
- Friendly competition among schools and districts
- Inform education leaders about what to expect, and how to allocate resources
- CFNC outreach representatives use the NC FAFSA Tracker regularly to measure impact in their regions

Track and rank school's progress toward 100% of their high school seniors completing the FAFSA.





# **FAFSA Tracker History**

(High School Seniors)

2015 Florida developed the first FAFSA Tracker

**2018** National College Attainment Network (NCAN) launched the #FormYourFuture FAFSA Tracker (all 50 states)

2020 MyFutureNC & UNC Carolina Demography collaboration


2022-2023 NCSEAA takes over FAFSA Tracker
